The EFPS online uniform shop is now open at https://efpspc.com/shop/

Please check us out, you can place an order right now - including of the **new faction shirts!** - and we will have it packed and available for pick up from the office. Once it is ready, you will receive a confirmation email. Please encourage your children to pick up the orders, they will need the order number and the surname the order has been placed under.

As this is a new system there are bound to be some teething problems, we welcome your feedback and suggestions and are happy to discuss the reasoning behind the decisions we have made thus far.

Next stage will be having an online interface at the uniform shop window so orders can be placed and paid via the online shop, while there in person. The uniform shop will continue to be open, so you can check sizes and buy second-hand items, from 8-9am on Assembly Friday mornings. Please note we are open this Friday, 8th Feb, from 8-9am.

Some things to note:

There is a \$1 "delivery fee" for items to be packed and picked up at the Uniform shop. If you are unhappy with this, you still have the option to attend in person. It was a requirement of the website apparently!

The faction shirts will take longer to arrive as they are being ordered as requested, not picked from stock already in the shop. **Kindly order your faction shirt by Friday 22nd Feb (end of week 3)**, otherwise the next faction shirt order will be later the year in time for athletics carnival. Please remember *only* these faction shirts with the school logo on them can be worn on "Faction Shirt Fridays". We will (hopefully) receive the shirts in time for the swim carnival at the end of March.

Your order will be packed in plastic bags that we have left over from years ago, once these are used up we will move to paper ones. However, if you would like, you can also order one of the cotton bags available in the shop, your items will be packed in that.
