2020 Voluntary Contributions and Charges Information to Parents

P&C Voluntary Contribution: \$10.00 per student is requested from the P&C to assist the school with resources for all our students. The contribution is given directly to the school.

Charges: Incursions/excursions, swimming lessons, dance and other charges that appear on the voluntary contribution and **charges** section of the sheet are **extra cost options that students must pay for upfront prior to the event**. The sheet shows the many and varied activities that are planned for during the school year. Not all students attend all these events but to participate, payment is required.

An invoice/statement will be sent home to all families **in February 2020** with the voluntary contribution and charges in relation to each student and their year level. Please pay this invoice by the end of Term 1 2020, or contact me if you wish to enter into a payment plan. I am more than happy to assist any family that wishes to discuss this with me.

LA SOSTA EXCURSION - A gastronomical extravaganza Tuesday 19.11.2019 Room 4 Year 5

On Tuesday 19.11.2019 the room 4 year 5 students were enormously privileged to attend genuine Italian cooking classes at the amazing La Sosta Restaurant in Fremantle. Owners Matteo and Simona Mussetti welcomed students into their restaurant and organised them into three working groups.

The ragu group were lucky enough to work with the brilliant head chef and owner Matteo. They finely chopped vegetables, used an industrial mixer to puree food and mixed vast pots of ingredients to produce the most delicious sauce for the pasta.

The focaccia group were lucky enough to work with the bread specialist Daniel. He taught students to mix the dough in the heavy duty machine and knead the dough for about 5 minutes. Then the students had to roll 250g of dough into perfectly round balls. This part was very challenging because the dough had to be extremely smooth. Then the dough was left to rise. Risen dough was then flattened, covered in olive oil, water, sea salt and rosemary. These were then cooked in the woodfire oven before serving.

The third group worked with the 'Master of Pasta' Giovanni. Students were taught how to mix the dough, 1 egg per 100gm of flour. It took a long time for the dough to mix. Students were then taught how to flatten the dough to prepare for the pasta machine. The dough was passed through the pasta machine 4 times until it became extremely long and transparent. It was then hung up to dry. Drying took no time at all. Finally the pasta was cut and torn into rustic strips. Matteo and Giovanni cooked the pasta, mixed it with the ragu and served it on plates. Daniel expertly baked the bread.

Students sat at tables in the beautiful restaurant and were served an amazing pasta and focaccia lunch. The food was sensationally divine. Year 5 student Jasmine Ingram said, "It was probably the best thing I have ever tasted in my whole entire life!" Everyone agreed with her.

Finally, there was a question and answer session. Students were able to find out anything they had ever wanted to know about running a fabulous restaurant. A wonderful day was had by everyone.

Year Three Students Visit the Perth Mint

After studying Heat Transfer, Melting, Freezing, Conductors and Insulators during Science, the Year Three students visited the Perth Mint to experience a Gold Pour. They were able to try to lift a gold ingot, see the world's largest gold coin and see some huge gold nuggets.

We often think our students are 'worth their weight in gold' and the children were able to weigh themselves to find out just how much their body weight in gold would be valued at.

While waiting for the bus, the children had fun answering questions about the Perth Mint displays, and earned a '99.5% pure plastic gold medal' for their efforts!

The Perth Mint Gold Pour demonstrator commended our students on the quality of the questions they asked about the Science of heating and melting gold, a great compliment for the knowledge they gained from their Science Investigations and Research.
